Home Learning Policy

From September 2021 will be using Google Classroom as our main Home-Learning platform. We aim for our offer to be *purposeful, engaging* and *manageable*.

Our arrangements for Home-Learning will be as follows:

Nursery and Reception: N & R will continue to send home the children's Wonder Books.

YEAR 1 & 2:

Similar to N & R, children will be sent home a Wonder Book **each week**. The Wonder Books will have the sounds and tricky words from the week to practise at home. In addition, there will be some suggestions for activities to take part in at home, or alternatively you can record any adventures the children have had at home.

YEAR 3 - 5:

Weekly Maths and GPS Home Learning:

Every week the children will be expected to complete **at least** 30 minutes on Times Table Rockstars. They will also have a weekly task on spag.com. Both websites will require a log-in which the children will receive, if they do not have one already. Both of these tasks will be assigned to the children on Google Classroom. Once they have completed their tasks for the week, they will be required to 'submit' their learning.

This will be set every Friday.

Half-Termly Creative Home Learning:

Each half term there will also be a task assigned to the children, on Google Classroom, linked to the current learning. There will be some creative activities suggested for the children and they will need to complete one creative activity over the half term. They can of course complete more linked learning if they would like to. The children will need to submit their learning online, but can also bring any learning into school.

YEAR 6:

Year 6 will have 3 pieces of Home-Learning per week. Every Monday they will be set an English activity on spag.com which will be due on Wednesday. Wednesday they will be set a maths activity via Google Classroom which will be due on Friday. On Friday they will be set a topic task which the children will have until Thursday to complete. This will also be shared on Google Classroom.

All Home Learning for Year 3 – 6 will go on Google Classroom in a Home Learning Topic Folder which will hold all the information about the weekly expectations, details of the creative task and information to support the creative task.
