Make a Papier Mâché Globe!

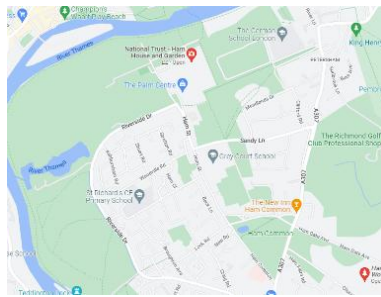

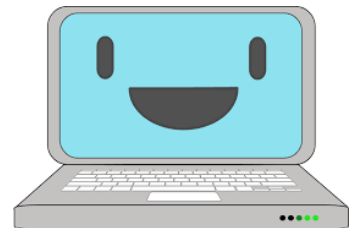
**Map work**

Practice your number bonds to 10. Can you remember them all?

Now try finding the number bonds to 20 using your knowledge of number bonds to 10.

If  $4 + 6 = 10$  then  $14 + 6 = 20$

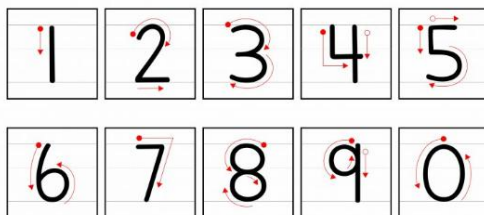
