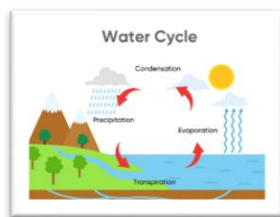
Slingshot cars!

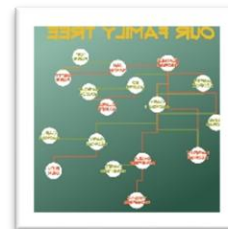
States of Matter
