Enough for Everyone

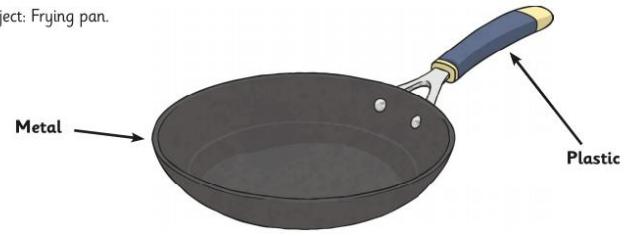
