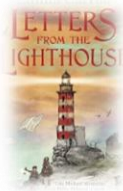
**Are those teeth your own?**

Make a poster or information leaflet for a child in KS1 to explain why it is important to look after our teeth and how we should do it.

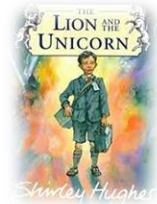


**Evacuation**
