



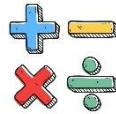

**MATHEMATICS**

**Task 1: Addition**

Choose 5 essential grocery items to buy online and work out the total cost.



**Task 2: Subtraction**

Work out how much time passes between two of your favourite events.

**Task 3: Multiplication**

Find a simple recipe for 4 people. Scale the recipe, as if you were making it for 12 people, by multiplying the ingredients. What would your totals be?

**ENGLISH & RE**

**Task 1:** Write a diary entry from Julie's point of view, looking back as an adult on her friendship with Chingis and Nergui.

*Extension:* Include a metaphor about a 'coat' to represent memories you carry with you.

**Task 2:** Reflect on how Julie tried to stand up for her friends. Write a short piece about a cause you would stand up for today and why.

*Extension:* Design a simple campaign poster to raise awareness for Courageous Advocacy.

**HISTORY**

**Task 1:** Choose one or more Maya god or goddess and create a "Top Trumps" card/s with their powers, symbols and importance.

*Extension:* Write your own short myth or story inspired by Maya beliefs.

**Task 2:** Build a model of a Maya pyramid using Lego, cardboard or other materials.

*Extension:* Write instructions or a step-by-step guide so someone else could build the same model.



**SCIENCE**

**Task 1:** Research a famous fossil discovery (e.g. Mary Anning; Archeopteryx; Lucy the Australopithecus.) Write a short fact file about what it taught scientists about evolution.

*Extension:* Create a timeline to show when this fossil existed compared to humans today.

**Task 2:** Imagine you are Charles Darwin on the Galapagos Islands. Write a diary entry about the finches you see and what you notice about their beaks.

*Extension:* Include sketches of the different beak shapes and explain how they help with survival.

**ART**

**Task 1:** Create a graffiti-style version of your name using bubble letters or block letters.

*Extension:* Experiment with colours, shadows and patterns to make it stand out.

**Task 2:** Research a famous street artist (e.g., Banksy, Keith Haring, Jean-Michel Basquiat). Create a short fact-file or poster about their style and most famous works.

*Extension:* Write your opinion in a paragraph: Is graffiti vandalism, art or both and give reasons for your opinion.



**COMPUTER**

**Task 1:** Design a colourful poster with your TOP 5 TIPS for staying safe online (e.g., strong passwords, not sharing personal details).

*Extension:* Include a catchy slogan to make people remember your message.

**Task 2:** Create 3 examples of strong passwords using a mix of letters, numbers, and symbols.

*Extension:* Explain why each password is stronger than something simple like "1234" or "password".
