- Follow our school behaviour policy and resolve any difficulties through a Restorative Approach
- Contact you as soon as possible if we have worries about your child's health, safety, work or behaviour

- Attend school on time every day
- Always treat others with respect
- Follow the school Faith ID by behaving well, being polite and helpful to others and doing their best at all times
- Work hard and listen carefully to instructions and each other
- Speak to a trusted adult if they are worried about anything
- Talk at home about what they learn at school
- Do all their home learning and try to catch up with any work that they might miss
- Wear their correct school uniform with pride
- Try to make a difference by being involved in the life of the school through sport, performances, special duties such as School Councillor, prefect etc.
- Always be kind and think carefully about choices they make

## Families will

- Always treat others respectfully in a polite and kind manner
- Make sure their child arrives at school every day promptly by 9.00am and is collected on time at 3.30pm
- Report any unavoidable absence by 9.00am
- Accompany EYFS child into class and encourage KS1 and KS2 pupils to make their way into class independently
- Make sure that their child wears the correct school uniform
- Follow our Communications Guidelines
- Support the Christian ethos of the school and encourage their child to follow the School Faith ID
- Work with the school to ensure that their child behaves well and enjoys their learning
- Encourage their child to work hard, do all home learning tasks and listen to their child read everyday
- Attend all Learning Conversations and discussions about their child's progress at school
- Reply to school correspondence
- Talk to a member of staff if they have any concerns
